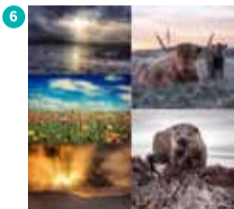

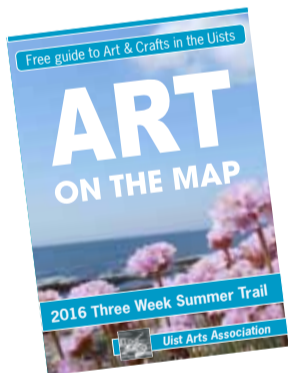
In 2003 the Uist Art Association got together and created, organised and ran Art on the Map, an open studio trail throughout the Uists.
